Pohangina Valley Community Committee (PVCC)

The PVCC's main roles are:

- Advocate for the Pohangina Community, ensuring MDC services and development of the Pohangina Region occur to the wishes of the Community.
- Provide an informal link between the community and the council making certain the MDC is aware of the Pohangina Community requirements and so an exchange of information, opinions, proposals, recommendations and decisions can take place.
- Make submissions on the Annual Plan and the Long Term Plan.
- Encourage the community to identify the issues they want to deal with and to generate local solutions.

Please consider joining the PVCC to ensure we continue to develop facilities and infrastructure in the Pohangina Valley.

We need new members to ensure the continued existence of the committee so that we have representation from as wide a selection of the community as possible.

Members of the PVCC are elected every three years and meetings take place monthly (except for December).

If you think that you may not have the time to attend all meetings there maybe others who are in a similar position and can share participation in the committee.

If we don't have an effective PVCC we cannot provide a voice to MDC when the Council does not meet our community needs. So **please** join the PVCC and help your community.

Over the last three years the PVCC has achieved the following:

- Establishment of The Culling River Accessway, providing access to the Pohangina River.
- Realignment of Howell's Gully.
- Updating the Pohangina Emergency Management Procedure.
- Restoration of the Pohangina Recreation Reserve.
- Improved recycling facility at Pohangina Village.
- Creation of the Pohangina Valley Community Trust.
